a busy girl



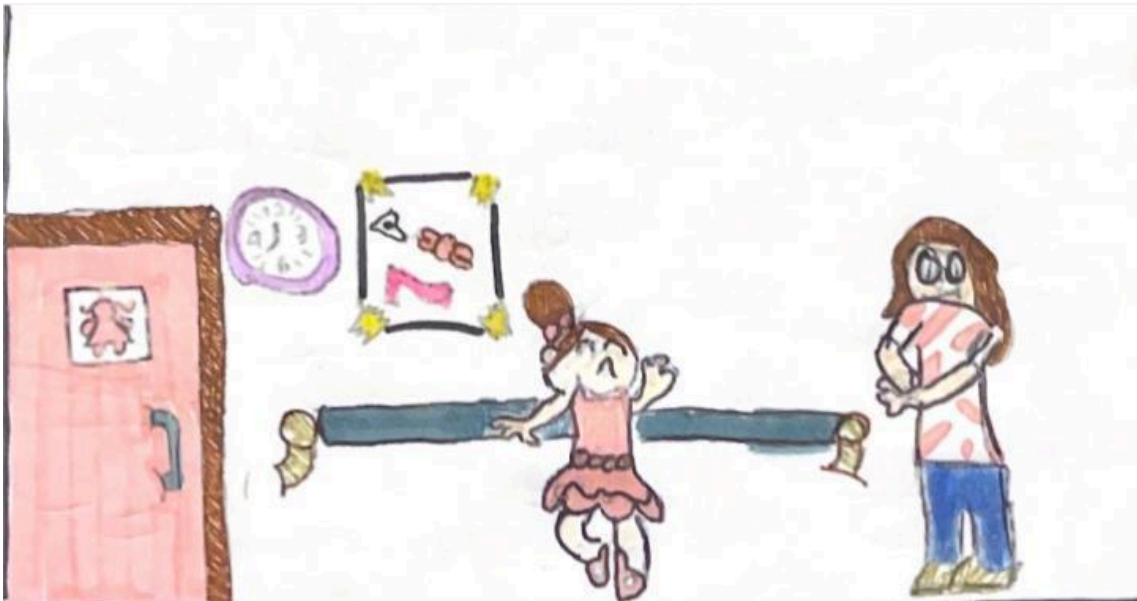
Mary wakes up every day at 6:00 am to go to school. There, she studies and talks to her friends.
