

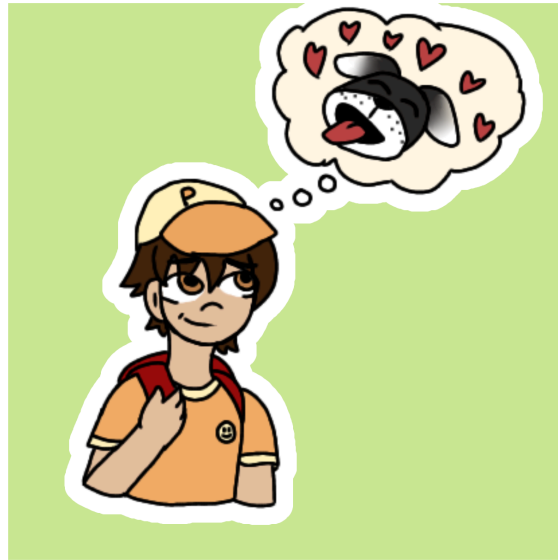
PETER and BOLT'S friendship

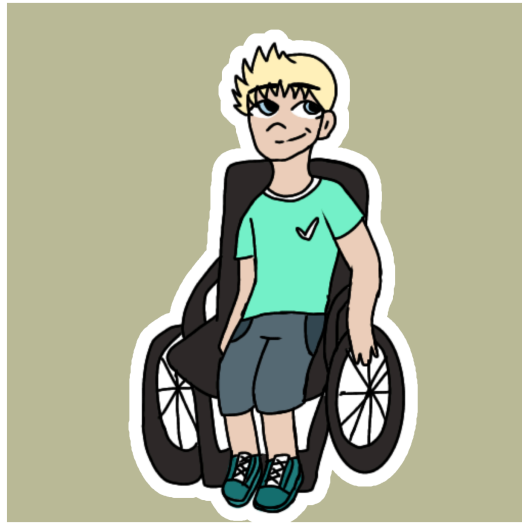

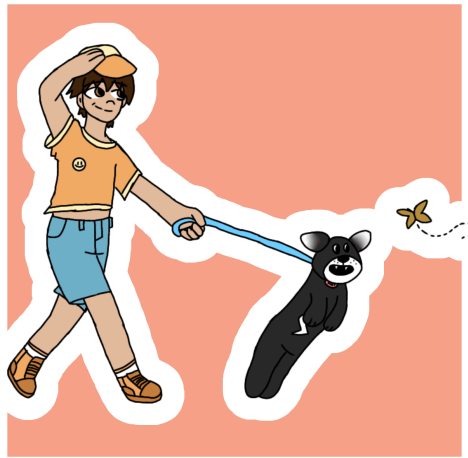
A Childhood Story
